Rising demand for streamlined resilient logistics networks and just-in-time delivery models is driving consolidation and strategic partnerships. For M&A professionals, this sector offers opportunities to acquire specialized service providers that can enhance multimodal connectivity, expand geographic coverage, or offer digital and automation capabilities. Notably, freight transportation arrangement and marine cargo handling are high-growth sub-sectors attracting private equity interest due to their recurring revenue potential and scalability.

With its integral role in global trade and exposure to high-growth e-commerce and

infrastructure trends, the industry remains a prime candidate for dealmaking centered around efficiency, scale, and digital transformation.

Historical PE Investments in Support Activities for Transportation

Support Activities for Transportation have consistently attracted a modest share of private equity platform investments, typically ranging between 2.0% and 2.5% since 2000.



The sector saw brief spikes in activity around 2005 and 2014 but has trended slightly downward in recent years. Despite this, it remains a stable niche for PE firms seeking steady, infrastruc-ture-adjacent opportunities.
